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## VX installed on steel structure above surface

Standard VX units are installed on 2 I beams, directly on the concrete floor as indicated on the picture below.



**If VX units are installed on a steel structure above ground level** several precautions must be considered. If the unit is installed more than 300mm above surface it is necessary for safety reasons to install a solid bottom panel to provide protection from moving parts ( sheaves, belts, motors, fan wheels, shafts,...).

Furthermore this solid bottom is required to ensure air is drawn horizontally into the cooling tower and not from the bottom. If bottom air is considered a reduction in air resistance to the fans occurs, resulting in higher air flow hence increased absorbed motor power. To avoid fan motor overload in these cases a reduction of fan speed is required (change motor pulley) to obtain normal motor current and airflow.
